

Fabric care guide



Routine maintenance

A weekly cleaning regime will help remove and prevent a build-up of dirt and dust that will affect the appearance and durability of the sofa. Gently wipe away any crumbs, vacuum along the seams and under the cushions, and refresh the cushion fabric with a drop of laundry detergent on a microfibre cloth, wiping over gently. It's also good to flip the cushions often to ensure they're always plump and looking their best.

Please note: The back cushions are reversible, but the seat cushions aren't.

Spillages

All our Payton sofas are suitable for dry cleaning. In the unfortunate event of a spillage, we recommend acting as quickly as possible to stop the liquid from absorbing into the fabric. First, dab the spillage with kitchen roll or a white bleach-free dry absorbent cloth to prevent further spread of the stain. Following this, contact a professional dry cleaning service for stain removal.

Annual cleaning

How often your furniture needs professional cleaning depends on how often you use it and how well it's maintained. As a guide, we'd recommend every 12 months.

Heat and sunlight exposure

Avoid placing your sofa next to radiators and windows because heat and prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause colour fading and impact the fabric's durability. Using curtains and blinds can help protect your furniture from deterioration.
